Preliminary Interest Application

The Center for Organ Recovery & Education (CORE) must obtain at least 250 preliminary interest applications before the Division of Motor Vehicles may begin the design and production of the license plate. This is why you are being asked to complete this application.

1. Please complete Part I of the application. The vehicle on which the plate will be placed must be a Class A (passenger car or truck). The vehicle must be currently titled in West Virginia. Leased vehicles are eligible for this plate.
2. There are no restrictions on the number of special license plates you may obtain.
3. This initial application process is only to determine whether or not CORE has the minimum level of interest to pursue the design and manufacturing of the new license plate. Please continue to renew your present license plate during this process.
4. The specialty license plates will expire July 1 of each year. DMV will mail you a renewal notice, and your renewal will be processed by DMV. The renewal fee will be \$45 per year.
5. CORE must submit the minimum number of 250 applications along with the fees to the DMV by December 12, 2006. If CORE fails to submit at least 250 applications by that date, the legislative authorization to issue the special license plate expires.
6. Please mail your application to CORE as soon as possible. The sooner CORE meets the minimum number of applicants, the sooner DMV can begin the design of the new license plate.
