

## CORE to fund Transplant Games' Pittsburgh team by matching license plate buys

The Center for Organ Recovery & Education said Thursday that it plans to make donations to the Transplant Games of America's Team Pittsburgh for every Donate Life license plate purchased in Pennsylvania and West Virginia through June 30.

The Transplant Games are scheduled to take place from July 11 to 15 in Houston. The games are a multi-sport festival for anyone who has received a transplant surgery and living donors.

O'Hara-based CORE will make a donation to match the cost of purchasing a Donate Life plate, which are available in Pennsylvania for \$22.50 and in West Virginia for \$45.
